How it works

Community superheroes are invited to host an **Information Booth** at **CulpeperCon** on **Saturday, March 28, 2026**, from **10:00 a.m.–5:00 p.m.** in **Culpeper County Library**.

(The evening of March 27 is for the Cosplay Runway & Contest only.)

Bring an **interactive element**—like as trivia, photo ops, or mini demos—to engage attendees. Small incentives (coupons or discounts) are encouraged to expand your reach beyond the event.

No selling, bartering, trading, or other transactions are permitted on Library premises.

Authors & Artists Fantasy/Sci-Fi authors & 2D artists (comic, graphic novelists, illustrators)

- Each author or artist receives an 8×8 ft. booth space inside the Library.
- Setup begins at 8:00 a.m.
- A time slot system may be used depending on space and the number of registrants.

Exhibitors Organizations celebrating graphic novels, pop culture, or storytelling.

- Each exhibitor receives an 8×8 ft. space inside the Library
- Setup begins at 8:00 a.m.
- Booths must remain open 10:00 a.m.–5:00 p.m.
